



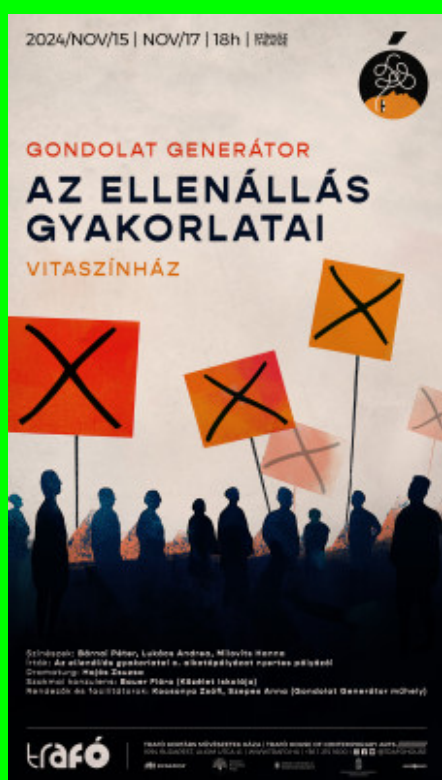

This time, the writers of the winning entries are civilians who have reflected on alternatives for action in our everyday struggles through scenes of theatre of debate.

The Trafó stage was transformed into a forum where our audience was invited to think together and share their opinions and ideas about resistance to oppressive power and possible forms of resistance, through the theatre scenes written by the contestants and the divisive statements they made.
