WORKSHOP CONTENT

The Burattino in Csepel (an industrial district of Budapest) is the only private institution in Hungary to integrate primary and secondary school, vocational training and a children's home. They believe in creating opportunities, that disadvantages can be overcome and that everyone has a talent.

In addition to social and mental support, Burattino aims to create the conditions for children to "outgrow" their disadvantages, mainly due to their social situation. This special situation leads to special pedagogical tasks. These include the organisation of development and cultural programmes in and out of school. Extra-curricular activities are highly effective for the development of young people. In the frame of this ambition/mission Trafó's participatory theatre workshop, Thought Generator during the first semester of the school year continuously worked with the graduating students of Burattino. After consulting with teachers and finding the right professional partners they launched the collaboration with a career guidance day at the Trafó. Together we watched performances (at Trafó) and had contextualising/interpretative discussions and special sessions about them. We organised an intensive theatre and sociodrama workshop for the Burattino class. To be continued in 2025.
